#### **INTRODUCTION TO THE WEBINAR**

Nurse Practitioners play an important role in managing the critically ill patients admitted in Intensive Care Units. These patients are often treated with variety of drugs like sedatives, antibiotics, neuromuscular blockers, inotropes and gastric acid suppressants. Many of these drugs require continuous monitoring of vital signs, or medication serum levels or organ function tests.

Some medications potentially interact with other medications, causing unwanted effects. Therefore it is critical for the Nurse Practitioners to thoroughly understand the pharmacology as well as the potentially fatal drug interaction.

The current webinar focuses on pharmacokinetics, pharmacodynamics and safe administration of medication to critically ill patients.
